The Urban Farm School was developed by Forsyth County Cooperative Extension Agents to teach students about creating and running a small market garden urban farm. The goal of this training program is to offer economic opportunity for underemployed participants in underserved communities, while increasing community involvement and access to local, healthy foods. Our model is to "teach one to fish", so that they can then feed themselves and others.

At the completion of this 12 week program, students earn a certificate of completion, gain work skills in gardening, learn produce handling and marketing, and are able to help feed their families and neighborhood. Additionally, students who successfully complete the Urban Farm School earn a stipend for their business start-up.
