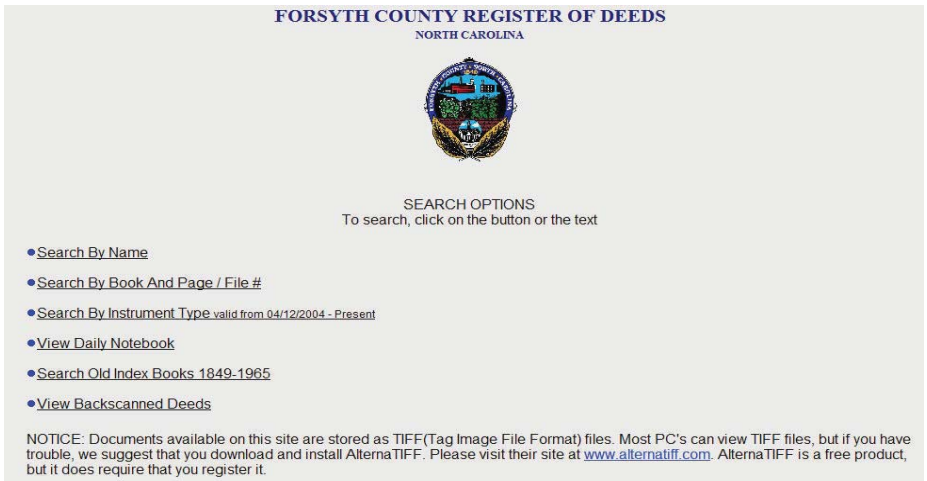

Public can search documents that are recorded by the Register's office the next day, dating back to 1973 for images and 1849 for deeds and indexes



Newly elected Forsyth Register of Deeds C. Norman Holleman makes good on his promise to provide "free" internet access to public records. A new lookup web portal in the Forsyth County Register of Deeds' office will make title and other real estate-related searches easier and more comprehensive. This free public web site will replace the pay-to-search web site that was previously provided by a third-party vendor. "Our office worked with our software vendor, Business Information Systems, to give the county a user-friendly web portal for the public to perform title searches and other necessary research for property sales and other transactions," said C. Norman Holleman, Forsyth County's Register of Deeds.

The new site will be online as of May 1, 2009. Forsyth County has over two million records and images stored in the system, as users can now search back to 1973 for Images and to 1849 for Deeds and Indexes.
