

**FORSYTH COUNTY, NORTH CAROLINA
AMENDMENT TO
2019-2020 BUDGET ORDINANCE**

EXPLANATION:

Forsyth County has offered a Wellness Program for several years to assist with making positive changes to improve health outcomes for its employees and retirees. As part of the County's Wellness Program, the Forsyth County Board of Commissioners approved a contract between the County and Wake Forest Baptist Health for corporate wellness services including biometric screenings and health coaching. In addition to these services, Wake Forest Baptist Health proposed that an onsite Wellness Clinic be established by the County and the Board of Commissioners approved this in the FY20 budget process with the cost being paid out of the Employee Benefits Internal Service Fund.

Forsyth County recently received \$50,000 for a wellness credit from its health insurance carrier, Blue Cross/Blue Shield of North Carolina, to be used for various wellness items such as fitness equipment, classes, and incentives. In addition to these items, staff has determined that these funds can also be used to offset costs related to the Wellness Clinic.

This agenda item is necessary to appropriate these funds to the General Fund for Human Resources to manage in order to reduce costs related to the Wellness Program.

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FORSYTH COUNTY BOARD OF COMMISSIONERS THAT THE FISCAL YEAR 2019-2020 BUDGET ORDINANCE IS HEREBY AMENDED AS FOLLOWS:
