March 12, 2026 – 2:00 p.m.

Meeting Called to Order

A meeting of the Forsyth County Board of Elections was called to order in the 2nd Floor Board Room on Thursday, March 12, 2026 at 2:00 p.m., Chairperson A.L. Collins presiding.

Pledge of Allegiance

Chairperson A.L. Collins led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Chairperson A.L. Collins led a moment of silence.

Motion to Approve Meeting Agenda

Chairperson Collins asked that an additional agenda item be added as #5.a. for the counting of four precinct transfer ballots. Member Draper moved to approve the agenda; Member Harvey seconded. **Motion carried unanimously.**

Counting of Four Precinct Transfer Ballots

Director Tsujii informed the Board that four ballots were returned on election night and were not counted due to an administrative error as these voters had recently moved. The ballots were not provisional ballots and should have been scanned on election night.

Ballots were scanned in front of the Board.

Approval of Provisional Ballots

Mr. Tsujii presented one provisional ballot that was originally disapproved due to missing DL/SSN information to be approved. A report received by the State Board of Elections confirmed the voter had timely updated their information with the DMV. Member Draper moved to approve the ballot; Member Harvey seconded. **Motion carried unanimously.**

Mr. Tsujii presented a provisional ballot to be partially counted due to a precinct error related to a voter unreported move. Member Draper moved to approve the ballot; Vice Chair Jourdan seconded. **Motion carried unanimously.**

Mr. Tsujii presented four provisional ballots for disapproval. Three were missing DL/SSN information and were mistakenly processed as regular ballots. The fourth ballot was from a voter who submitted their registration application after the deadline. Vice Chair Jourdan moved to accept the disposition as disapproved for the 4 ballots presented; Member Draper seconded. **Motion carried unanimously.**

Approval of Absentee Ballots

Macy Payne, Absentee Manager, presented one military absentee ballot with an ID exemption form to the Board for review. Vice Chair Jourdan moved to approve the one absentee military ballot; Member Draper Seconded. **Motion carried unanimously.**
